## According to the audit team, Novia's key strengths and areas for development are

### **Strengths**

- Working-life relevance is a principle that strongly guides the planning and implementation of degree programmes.
- Novia's five campus areas are a result of systematic interaction with the business sector and other regional actors. The campus areas provide a good basis for Novia's operations.
- The quality system is implemented in a way which supports the institution's strategic development work.
- The Nordic cooperation and networks enrich and enhance Novia's operations.

- The sharing of information and knowledge between Novia's units and focus areas could be strengthened.
- Novia can further develop the ways in which good practices are shared systematically within the institution.
